

PEACE POSTER CONTEST

DEADLINE FOR ORDERING KIT IS OCTOBER 1, 2010.

Purpose and theme: The Peace Poster is a way to get the world's youth, ages 11-13 thinking of participating in world peace. The theme of the 2010-2011 is **"VISION OF PEACE"**.

How to get started: Go to groups that may be interested. Start with the art department in your local school. Explain the age groups and who can participate. Get a commitment.

How to order kit and when: One kit for each poster your club sponsors can be ordered immediately from Lions Clubs International Club Supplies Sales Dep., or by calling 1-800-710-7822, or off the web at www.lionsclubs.org. The kit can be ordered by your club's secretary. A special certificate comes in the kit for the local winner.

What are the rules? Follow the rules EXACTLY as printed in the kit. It tells size, where to place name and location, how to handle the poster and exactly what rules to follow. November 15, 2010 is the deadline for submitting poster to district governor.

When is poster to be judged on local level and by whom? Judging should take place in early November. Local judges should be used, those who know art. **Be sure to fill out the top portion of the sticker that needs to be attached to the back lower right corner of the winning poster.**

Should local club give prizes? If so, what? After a local judging takes place, local clubs generally give three top prizes. A range of prizes can be set, using any denominations that your club chooses. These prizes should be given at some kind of ceremony at the school with a Lion present.

When and to whom should poster be delivered? The poster should be delivered to the District Peace Poster Chairperson (Lion Doreen Mrotek) or the District Governor by November 15, 2010.

Then What? The #1 winning poster in District E1 will be sent by the District Governor to Multiple District 27. All other posters will be kept and put on display the District E1 Convention in April. The prize money at the District level is \$50, \$30 and \$20. The Multiple District winner will go on to the International completion.
