YOUTH SERVICE PROJECT AWARD

The Lions and Lioness Clubs of District 27-E1 are sponsoring a Youth Service Project Award program to recognize and encourage service learning in our Northwest Wisconsin area. This program is meant to be promoted by local Lions, Lioness, and Leo Clubs of District 27-E1.

Local clubs are encouraged to identify service activities carried out by school or youth groups. Examples include Leo Clubs, church groups, 4-H Clubs, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, school organizations, Boys and Girls Clubs, and other similar youth volunteer organizations. Lion and Lioness Clubs may choose to sponsor a local area contest of their own design. Each Lion and Lioness Club may select a nominee to be entered into the District Contest. A Leo Club may nominate itself for the District Contest.

The District Winners will be selected by a team of judges headed by the Youth Activities Chair and at least two members of the District Cabinet. The District Winners will be recognized during the District 27-E1 Convention in Siren on April 10, 2010.
